PURPOSE

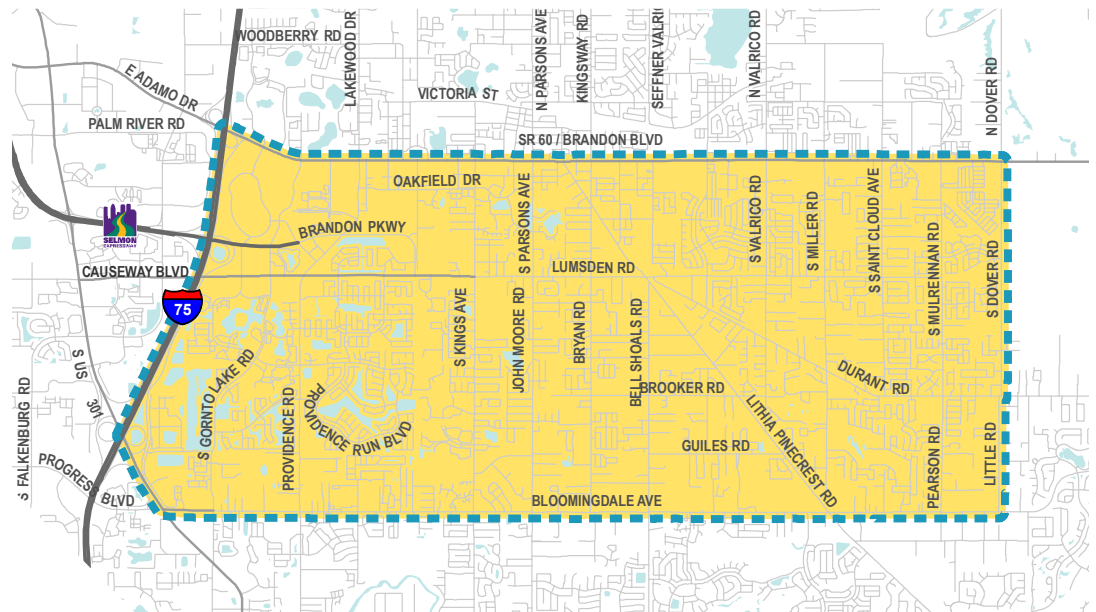
The Brandon Corridors and Mixed-Use Centers Study is a joint pilot project of the Hillsborough Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and the Planning Commission. The purpose of the study is to better coordinate Brandon's land use pattern with practicable and fundable transportation improvements along major corridors. Brandon's east-west corridors of State Road 60/Brandon Boulevard, Lumsden Road, and Bloomingdale Avenue connect much of the residential and commercial development within the study area to Interstate 75, Lee Roy Selmon Expressway and US 301.
