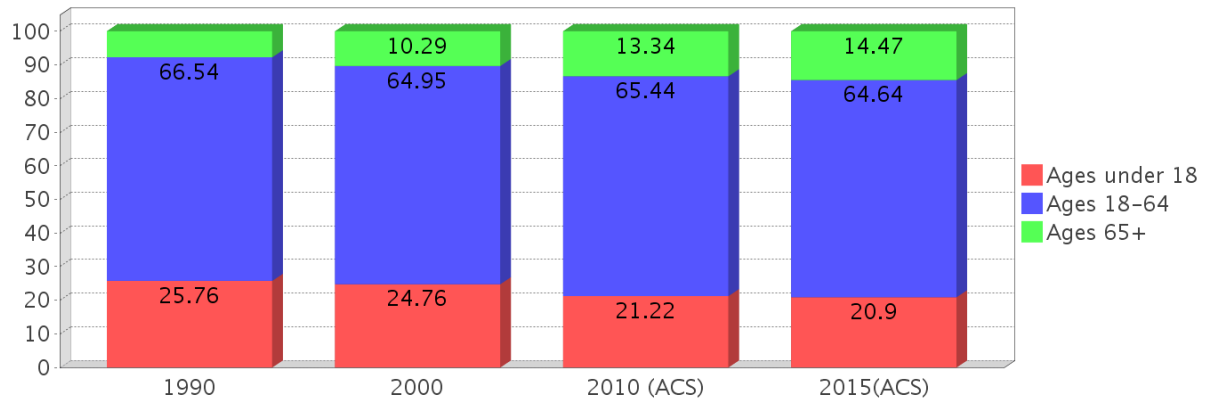

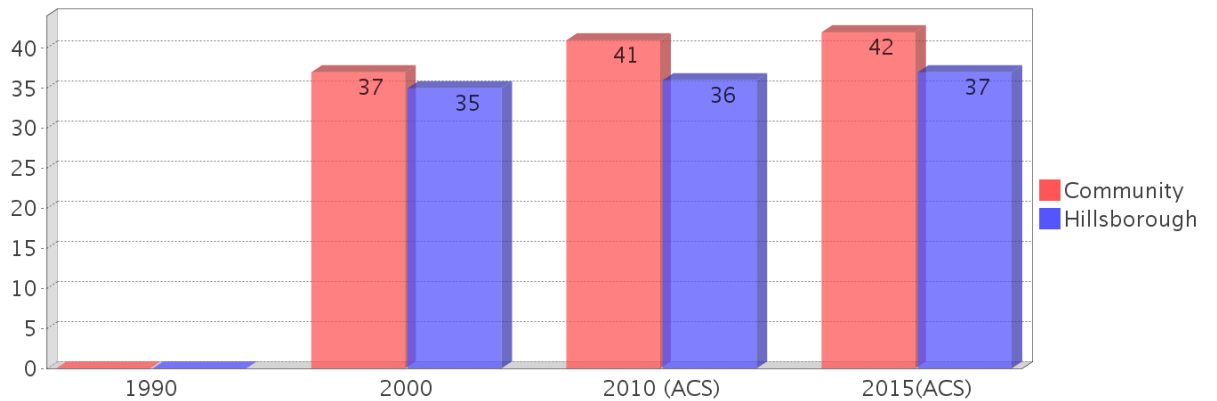
Population by Age Group

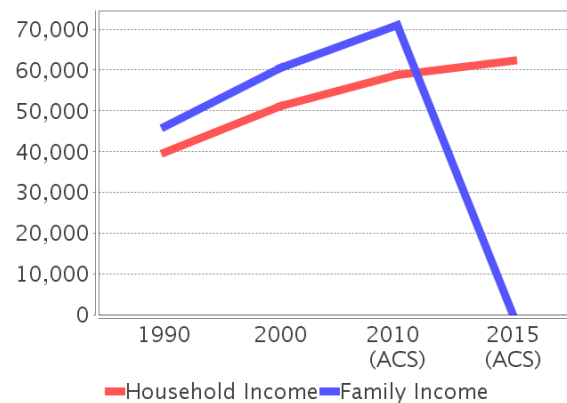

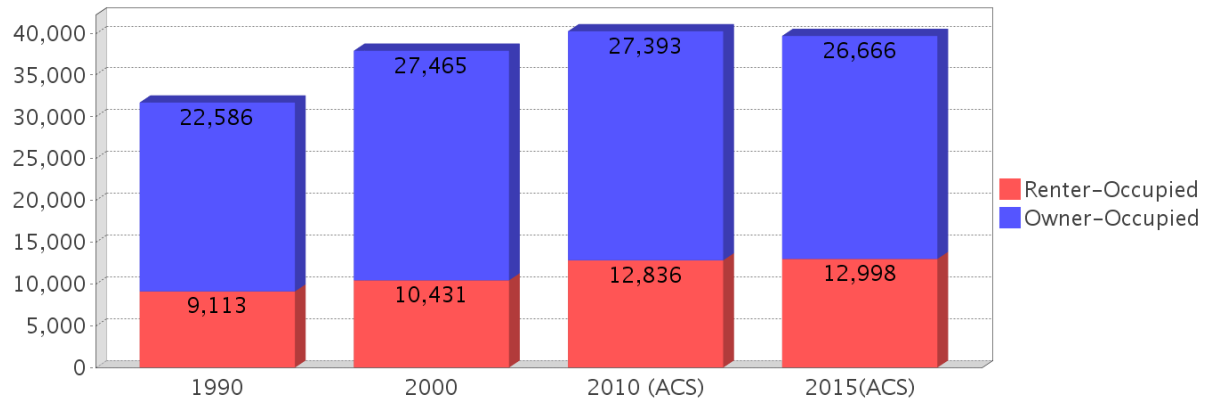

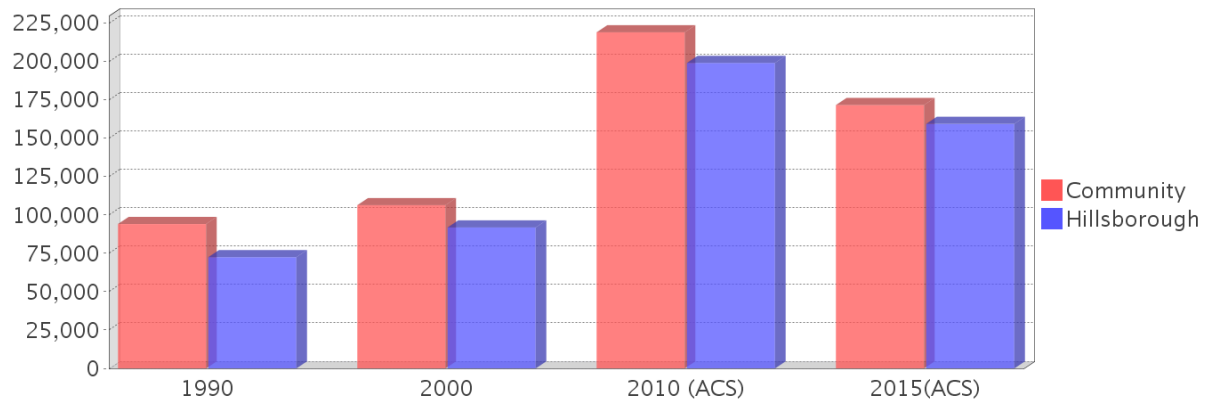

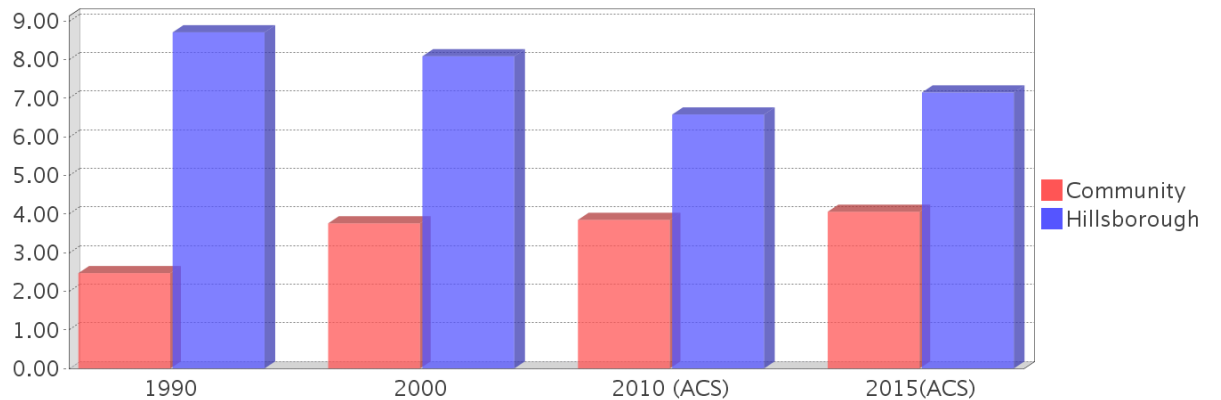
Housing Tenure



Median Housing Value Comparison

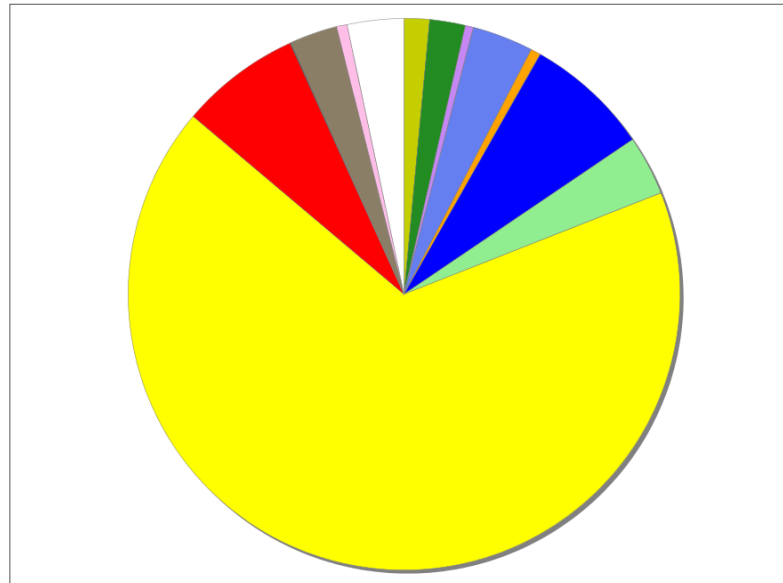

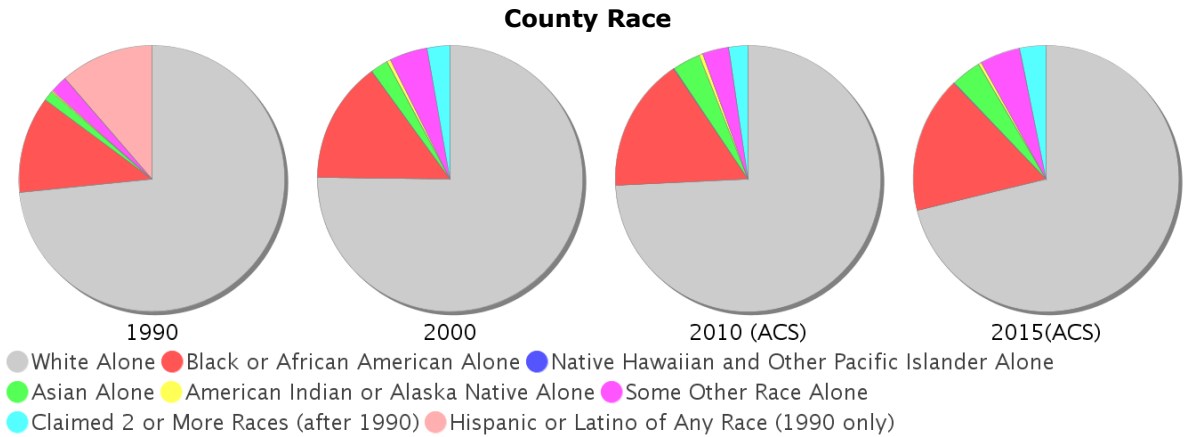

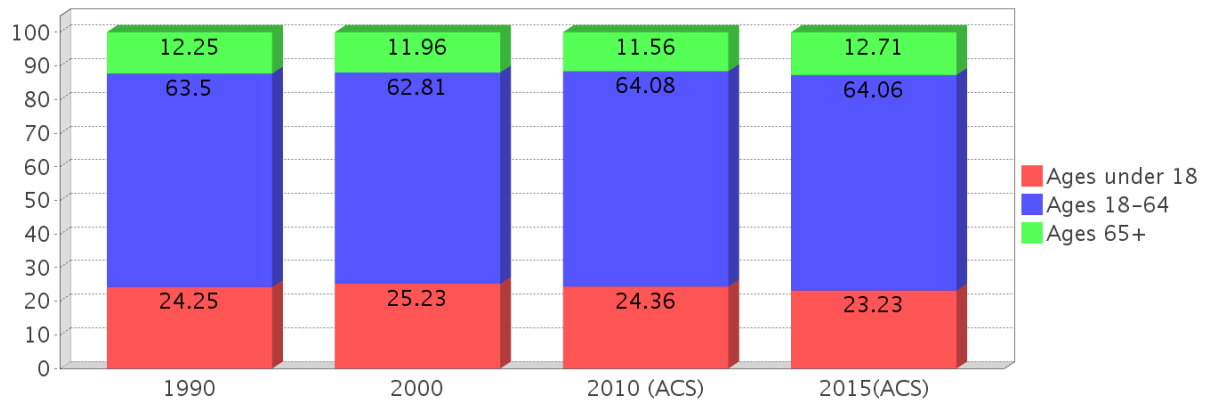

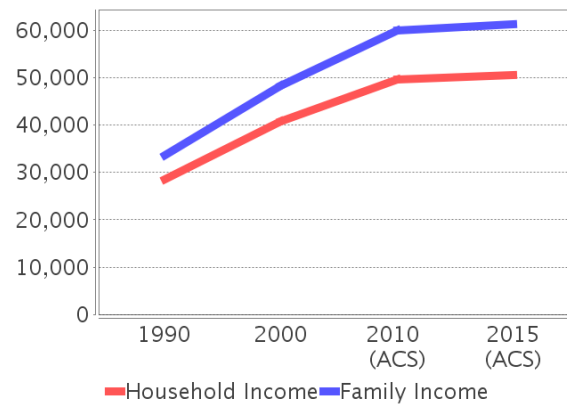

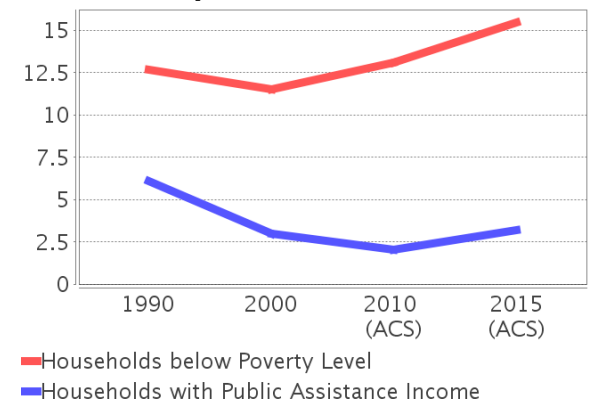

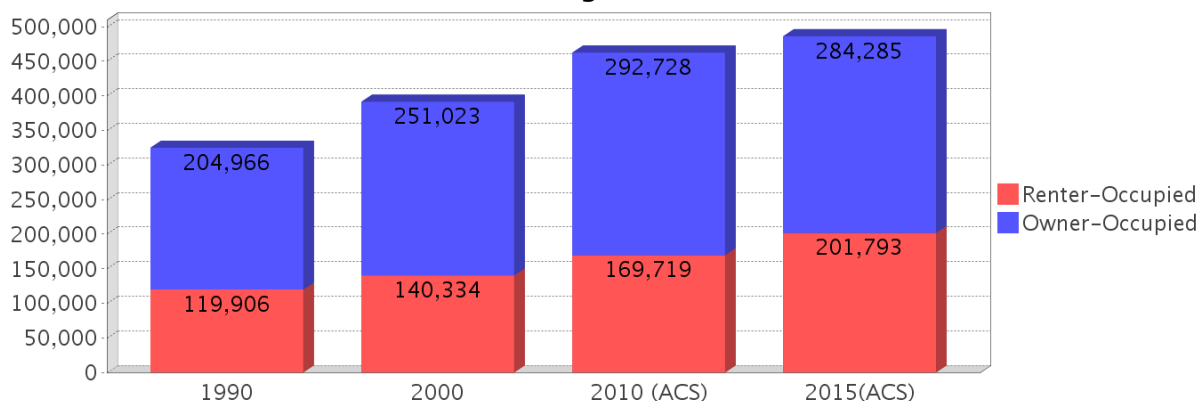
