


Federal & State: Capacity & Non-Capacity






Transit – Federal and State Programs, FY 2031-FY 2050






Federal & State: State Fuel Taxes to Local Transportation Programs



 Surtax (Transportation Surtax) no sooner than 2029
- Ad Valorem Taxes
- Off-Street Parking



Potential New Local Funding Sources, FY 2031-FY 2050


