- Document and coordinate federal and state funding for transportation planning that's conducted by: TPO, FDOT, HART and the Commission on Transportation Disadvantaged (CTD)
- Complies with federal & state rules
- Outlines major planning tasks
- Is the TPO budget
- Effective July 1, 2024 June 30, 2026



Schedule & Milestones



- ✓ March: UPWP draft submitted to FDOT for review
- ✓ April: Committees and required agencies provide comment & feedback on draft document
- May: TPO Board Approval & FDOT submittal by 5/15
- July: New UPWP becomes effective 7/1/2024
